SERVING TEMPERATURE: 18° - 20° C

Just across the river from its burlier cousin Barolo, in the gentle hills of Barbaresco, Nebbiolo finds a softer, more elegant expression. Here, the morning mists rise from the Tanaro River, and the vines soak in a slightly warmer, more forgiving climate. In the glass, Barbaresco shimmers with a luminous garnet red, fading gracefully to a delicate orange-tinged rim – a preview of the amber hues that time will bestow. This is a wine of silken power and restrained majesty.

The nose is a poetic tapestry: dried roses and violets mingle with red currants, wild cherries, and a whisper of liquorice, all framed by ethereal notes of tobacco, white truffle, and a hint of balsamic herbs. On the palate, it is elegance personified – fine-grained, silky tannins that caress rather than grip, supported by a lively acidity that keeps everything in perfect balance. Flavours of sour cherry, raspberry, and dried rose petal unfold across the palate, leading to a finish that is long, refined, and hauntingly persistent.

Barbaresco is Nebbiolo at its most graceful – approachable earlier than Barolo, yet capable of ageing beautifully for 10–15 years or more. Enjoy it now with a decanter to unlock its aromatic treasures, or cellar it patiently to witness its evolution into a wine of ethereal complexity, where fruit mellows into leather, dried flowers, and savoury earth. The ideal partner to roasted meats, game, truffle risottos, and aged Parmigiano-Reggiano.
